15 Ways To Kill Your Ham Radio Club

- 3) Ignore All Guests You didn't invite them, so why be nice to them?
- 4) Don't Check Into The Club Traffic Net There are many other nets out there.
- 5) Don't Obey Part 97 Of The FCC Rules They don't apply to you.
- 6) Complain Gee Whiz, can't they do anything right??
- 7) Gripe About The Club Officers But never, do anything to help.
- 8) Never Serve On A Committee For A Hamfest Or Otherwise And if you are put on one, "nuts" to them. There are plenty of other folks to do the work.
- 9) Deride Those Who Use Internet Modes, As Well As Those Who Never Did A CW Exam Internet Radio Is Not Ham Radio, and CW is the real proof you are a ham.
- 10) Never Invite Guests It's too much trouble; but if you do, be sure they are below the emphasis of your club.
- 11) Don't Learn Anything New You know enough to get by; how can you be sure something new will be fun??
- 12) Jabber And Talk While The Meeting Is Going On You're not interested in what the speaker is saying, so why should anyone else be??
- 13) Don't Smile Show everyone you aren't having a good time.
- 14) Belittle Your Club Tell everyone how good the other area clubs are.
- 15) You're Always Right Everyone else makes mistakes, not you.

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
