

How To Contact Daryl Stout, NK5LA – last updated on June 12, 2026

1) Via Postal Mail to P.O. Box 55655, Little Rock, AR 72215 -- I check the P.O. Box once or twice a month, but no more. I don't drive anymore due to dry corneas and suspect glaucoma, causing intermittent blurred vision. Plus, I had to get a P.O. Box, due to people stealing items from my QTH mailbox. With a shortage of drivers via Lyft, a roundtrip can run \$100 or more, and I don't have that kind of money.

2) Via Website Feedback to <http://www.wx4qz.net/fbk.htm> – spam safeguards are in place. While it has a previous callsign in the domain, it's too costly and tedious to change the domain/HTML.

3) Via my ham radio/weather telnet BBS at either tboltbbs.synchro.net or to wx4qzbbs.ddnsfree.com (via a Telnet Client such as SyncTerm). Choose the FEEDBACK option at logon, and leave your email address if you want a reply.

4) Via email to either to n5vlz@duck.com or to yhfnetmanager@qcwa.org

5) I'm on X (formerly Twitter) – look for @wx1der – this is used sparingly.

6) I'm on Facebook – look for the Train Conductors Outfit. Note that I'm very selective on Friend Requests.

7) For licensed Amateur Radio Operators:

A) I run the following traffic nets during the week (all times US Central) – you do NOT have to be a member of the QCWA to check into any of their nets. First time checkins on the Trains And Railroads Net can get a commemorative PDF certificate via email request.

Sunday Afternoon: QCWA Digital Net, 4pm – XRF 757A (D-Star)(openquad.net)

Sunday Evening: Arkansas D-Star Net, 8:30pm – REF 77 A (as backup NCS)

Monday Evening: The PCL Net, 7pm – NS2B BBS (see item C on the next page)

Monday Evening: The Pun In Life Net, 9pm – XRF 757A (D-Star)(openquad.net)

Wednesday Evening: Arklatex D-Star Net, 8:30pm – REF 48 B, backup REF 73 B (D-Star)

Friday Evening: Trains And Railroads Net, 7pm, XRF 757A (D-Star) (openquad.net)

1st and 3rd Saturday Evening:

QCWA CQ200 Net, 8pm, 14.347 Mhz on CQ200

QCWA 158 Net, 9pm, XRF 757A

The 2 nets are CANCELED the first Saturday of January and July, as I have a schedule conflict that weekend.

I've joined the staff of Net Controls for the Handi-Hams Midday Net as a backup, in case the regular net control stations can't make it, as is the case with the Arkansas D-Star Net. I'm also Net Control for The Weather Watch Net, a precursor to Arkansas Skywarn ®. When The Weather Watch Net needs to be activated, my regularly scheduled nets are CANCELED.

B) Echolink, D-Star, D-Rats, APRS (NK5LA-G), CQ200, Fusion, NXDN, and Packet Via Telnet, for sked requests.

C) I'm on the NS2B Packet BBS in Penfield, New York – see the file on “The PCL Net” for more details. My address is NK5LA@NS2B.#WNY.NY.USA.NOAM -- a packet mail program (Outpost) is required. If sent from a regular email client, the address will BOUNCE as undeliverable.

D) "Eyeball QSO's" are done at ham radio license exam sessions at the University Of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR). See the file at <http://www.wx4qz.net/elk.htm> for info. Also on that page, are Excel Spreadsheets of Selected D-Star, Echolink, and D-Rats Nets, in the 4 main US Time Zones, plus PDF files related to ham radio.

E) HamsOverIP (101797) and F) AmateurWire (1577) – please leave a message.

One does NOT need “a hard phone” for access, and I'll be using my Android phone for them. More info is at <https://hamsoverip.com/> and <https://amateurwire.org/>, respectively -- you will need to supply an OFFICIAL copy of your amateur radio license, and DMR ID if you have one when you register. If you upload a REFERENCE copy of your license, your access application will be REJECTED.
