! For AXIP Network Users: At any AXIP or BPQ32 Packet node, look for and connect to PACNET.

! For Outpost, Winpack and HyperTerminal Users: (Contact NS2B for your Username and Password.) Using TelNet (iptelnet with the Outpost Packet Program is recommended), connect to ns2b.ddns.net Port 8010. When connected, enter PCL and press <ENTER>.

! For Internet users: (Contact NS2B for your Username and Password.) With your browser, connect to: <http://ns2b.ddns.net:8080/Node/Terminal.html?pcl>

Note that the HF connection option is no longer available; our apologies for any inconvenience.
