

UTC Times And Info On Other Net/Mode Links: Updated July 24, 2023

To convert the USA Time to UTC (GMT) Time, the difference between US Eastern Time and UTC is 4 hours from the 2nd Sunday in March to the 1st Sunday in November; 5 hours the rest of the year. Arizona, Hawaii, and some US territories, are on Standard Time year round. GMT is based on the time at the Greenwich Meridian in England.
